

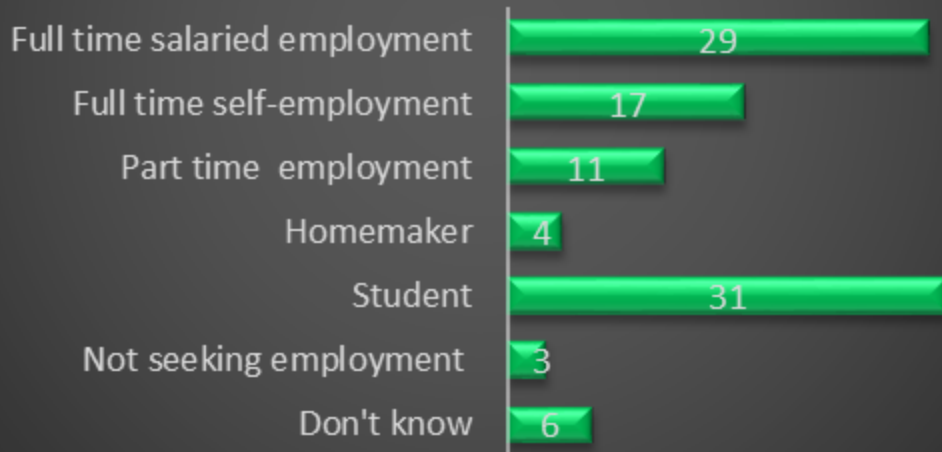
Most refugees in the UK plan to stay and settle here. Most of those in Greece would like to move to another European country. For those in Lebanon, over a third would like to go back to Syria.

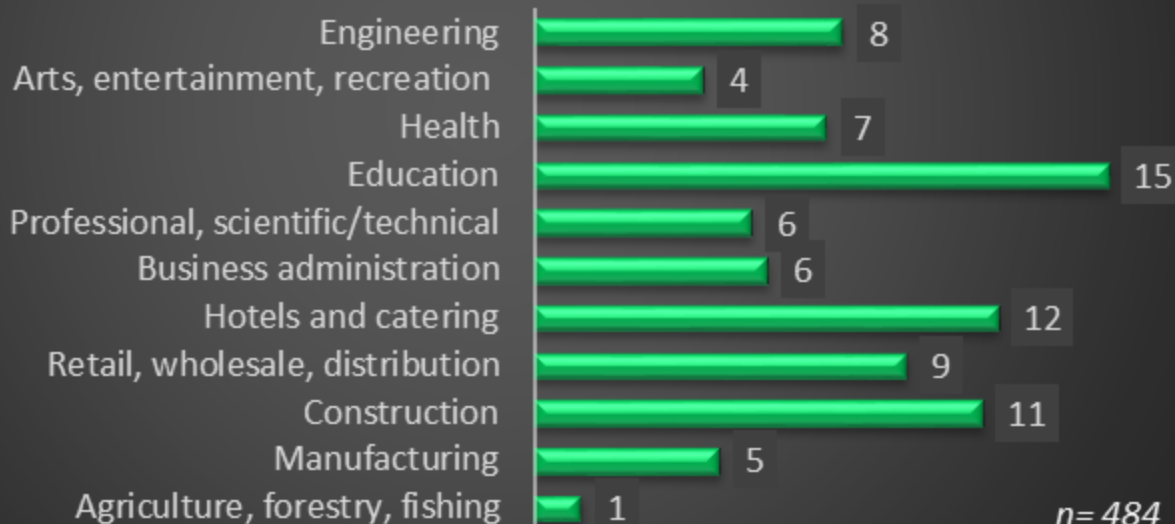
