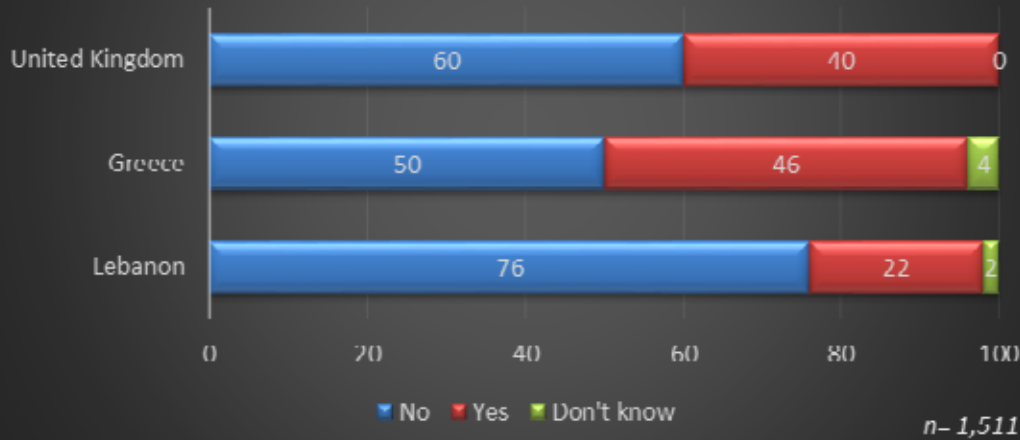


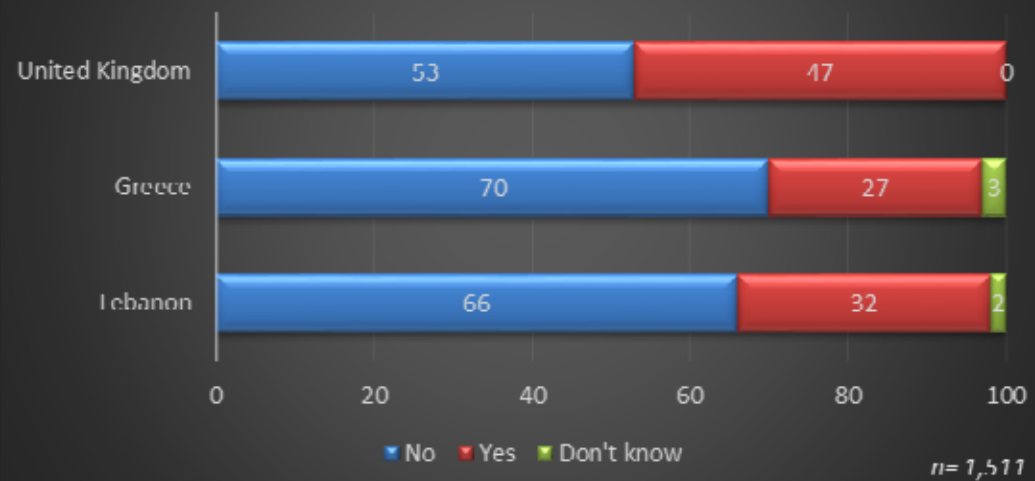
## Was your education interrupted by the conflicts? (%)

## Do you have any documentation with you to verify your educational qualifications? (%)



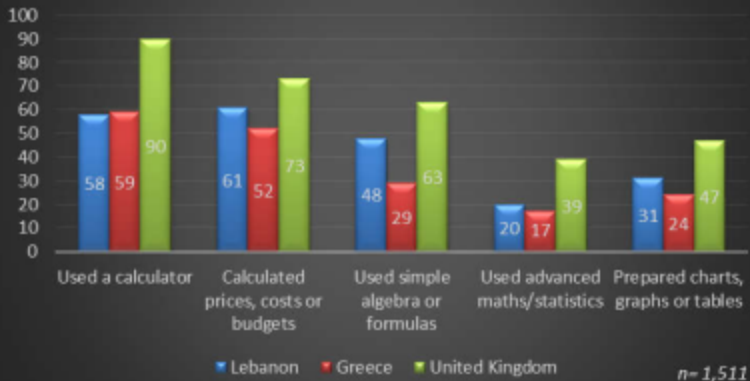
## Compared to Greece and Lebanon Syrian refugees in Britain have higher qualifications

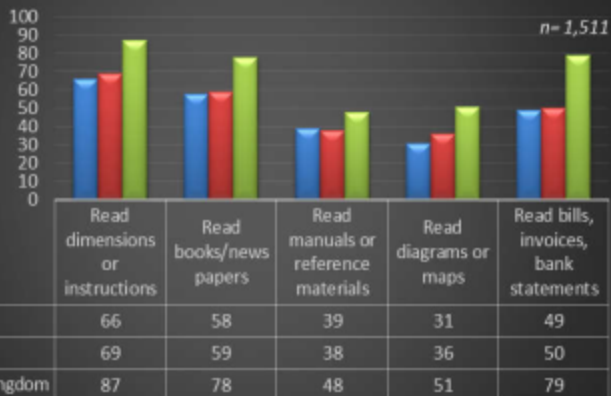
## Numeracy Skills: 'Have you ever...?' (%)



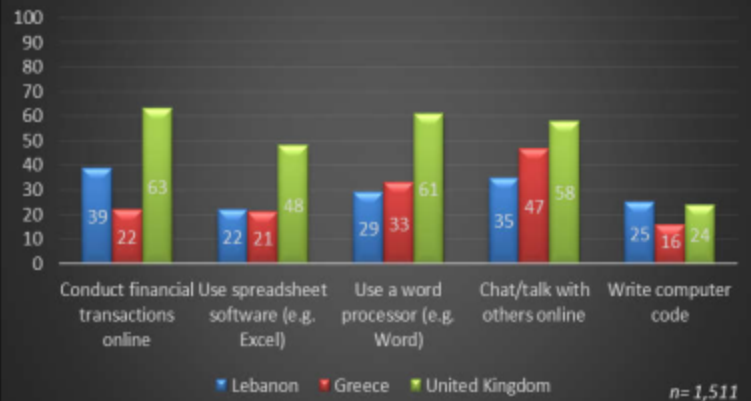
## Writing Skills: 'Have you ever...?' (%)
